This structured wine opens with aromas of red and black berry, spices and a whiff of coffee. The palate displays Serralunga's tannic power, offering rich black cherry flavors accented with vanilla, mint and baking spices alongside bracing tannins and racy acidity. It's still young and austere with great aging potential. Drink after 2022.
