BARBARESCO MONTERSINO 2018

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Vivid red with some orange at the rim. The slightly evolved, forward nose hints at apricot, orange and red cherry. Mineral red cherry flavours and hints of blood orange on the palate. Finishes broad and savoury. I like this because it does feature some easy to recognize elements that are typical of the Montersino cru, but I really wouldn't hold on to it for very long as it's already very open-knit. Drinking window: 2025-2030.
